MAJOR LIFE ACTIVITIES

Section 504 defines a person with a disability as having a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or more major life activities.

Criteria Part 1 - Impairment:

A physiological condition that affects a bodily system, or any mental or psychological disorder. Some conditions include:

Allergies Arthritis Asthma
ADD/ADHD Bipolar Cancer

Cerebral Palsy AIDS Cystic Fibrosis

Diabetes Drugs/alcohol Emotionally Disturbed
Encopresis/Enuresis Epilepsy Hearing Impairment
Learning Disability Leukemia Orthopedically Impaired
Student with health needs Tourette's Syndrome Traumatic Brain Injury
Tuberculosis Visual Impairment Weight (obesity, anorexia,

bulimia)
