504 PLAN ACCOMMODATION EXAMPLES

Examples of 504 plans for specific disabilities are often listed on the websites of national disability organizations. Below are some examples.

Diabetes:

- private space and time to monitor glucose levels
- ability to eat snacks when needed
- chance to make up missed work due to illness
- training of staff in a health plan

NOTE: Schools cannot require parents to come to school to administer medication.

ADHD:

- chunking assignments into small parts with due dates spaced throughout
- seating away from distractions
- short breaks to regain focus
- shortened homework assignments
- supervision on outings
- quiet setting for tests
- two sets of books
- services in a behavior support plan
- supervision of medication

Depression or Anxiety:

- extended time for tests
- shortened assignments
- modified schedule
- ability to take breaks in quiet setting
- time for appointments with counselors/mental health professionals

Severe Food Allergy:

- emergency health plan
- lunch table free from allergen
- ability to keep safe snacks at school for special occasions
- supervision of medication

Dyslexia:

- extra time for reading
- assistive technology
- shortened homework assignments
- note taker for class
